Practical Info Exhibitors

Name and no plate: Is on your table and must be clearly visible throughout the fair for guests

ID: Is displayed on your stand, must be worn visibly throughout the fair by exhibitors.

Company signage: Signage with clear company information is your own responsibility

Responsibility: Exhibitors are responsible for what is on display

Opening hours: Saturday and Sunday both days 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Set-up: Friday 14:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. and Saturday 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.

Table arrangement: Tables may not be moved around and other tables may not be set up as extensions to the stands unless agreed in advance.

Price marking: All products must be clearly price marked

Welcome meeting: Saturday at 9.45 in the meeting point

Exhibitor meeting: Saturday at 17.00 – 17.30 with the possibility of trading

Insurance: Exhibitors covered by their own insurance

Lighting: Everyone brings their own lighting and their own extension cord.

Open fire/lights: Smoking and candles not allowed

Waste: Bring your own or refer to container

Internet: Wifi code provided upon arrival at the hall.

Shared dinner: Turkish bufe in the cafeteria, price 175,-kr, payment to mobilepay

Cafeteria: All purchases are settled directly with the cafeteria. No drinks from outside in to the cafeteria area.

Food and Beverages: You are welcome to bring them into the hall.

Dismantling: No dismantling before Sunday at 17.00, hall closes at 20.00

Surveillance: Odense Municipality installed cameras in the hall.

Toilets: 7 toilets located in each hall, 14 in total

Parking: Parking options around the hall. Exhibitors are directed to the rear exit by the ramp at Søren Eriksens Vej, entrance opposite H. Knudsen and Søn. Guests are directed to Maylandsvænget and Søren Eriksens Vej.
